IN TODAY'S GOSPEL...

In Prophet Ezekiel's story of the fall of the king of Tyre (Ez 28). The Church Fathers saw a description of the sin of the king of demons. He was the "great cherub", he walked in Eden. He reflected perfection. What was his fault?

He loved the beauty within himself. His heart became haughty because of... beauty. He was delighted with his self-sufficiency. Hmm... How do I know this state of mind?

Ezekiel prophesies in chapter 28 of his book:

"Son of man, raise a lamentation against the king of Tire and say to him: Thus says the Lord God: You were the image of perfection, full of wisdom and incomparably beautiful. You dwelt in Eden, the garden of God (...) I placed you as a guardian over the great cherub on the holy mountain of God; you walked among the shining stones. You were perfect in your ways from the days of your creation, until iniquity was found in you. Because of the flourishing of your trade, your interior was filled with oppression and you sinned, so I threw you down from the mountain of God, and as a guardian cherub you disappeared among the shining stones. Your heart has become haughty because of your beauty, your prudence has faded because of your splendor. I threw you to the ground and gave you up to kings as a spectacle. (...) I caused fire to come out from within you to consume you, and I reduced you to ashes on the ground in the sight of all those who looked on you."

For the rest of my life I will remember the when many years ago someone a priest told me in polish: "Uważaj na siebie!" which can be translated to English as: "Take care of yourself!" or "Be careful with yourself!". At first I thought that the "attack" would come from outside, but I quickly discovered what he wanted to tell me: The truth is painful: I am my own greatest threat. In Latin it is called: SUPERBIA, in English is simply: PRIDE.
