When Peter heard the announcement of passion, rejection, and resurrection, he tried to kindly influence Jesus to change his decision. We can believe in Jesus triumphant, but when he talks about defeat, we tremble and press that it doesn't happen. Like a parent who cannot come to terms with an illness, addiction or life loss of their own child. This is the first instinct of natural love.

I wonder if sometimes the concern of many parents for the well-being of their child is not hidden by egocentrism, which wants its own satisfaction with the success of its offspring? Was Peter truly concerned about Jesus' fate, or was he afraid that he would have to suffer alone while Jesus suffered? Jesus says to Peter that he is a hindrance and the Greek language did not hesitate to sound disturbing here: SCANDALON! The need to transform thinking from the pursuit of contentment to what makes us real. Being real is much more important than being satisfied. Jesus could, of course, at Peter's urging, have provided a home of his own on the beaches of Haifa, but then where would we all end up? In the amber chambers of heaven or in the musty cellars of hell?

When Paul asks his addressees for a change of mind, he uses a word that can be translated as transformation, that is, an absolute change of form. Jeremiah tried to extinguish this process of transformation and trembled with fear of shaping his inner self in the fire of the truth of God's words, even to being true to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Being true sometimes costs martyrdom. If I'm real, I'll be hated one day, if I don't want to be hated, I must be opportunely lying. Therefore, Paul called not to imitate the world, the requirements of the era, fashions, trends, but to transform the mind to please God. And what does He like best if not the truth? And finally, Peter, who with genuine kindness wants a trouble-free fate for Jesus. If Jesus had listened to Peter, he would have become a hypocrite and a compromiser, a nice rabbi invited to Caiaphas' feasts because of his astonishing erudition.

The mind-transformation effect does not end with Golgotha, it is only outlined on Tabor. The transfigured Jesus revealed for a moment the truth of His Face, which shone as brightly as the sun. The same Piotr then utters more than kind words: "it is good that we are here". He tried to hold back the moments of transfiguration. Yes, man will be fine only in the face of God. Paul says that with uncovered faces - without hiding behind a mask of naive kindness - we are already looking at the Lord's brightness, as if into a mirror, becoming more and more radiant. He who sees can open the eyes of others. We are not only to look at Jesus, but also to preach about Him in order to dissuade as many minds as possible from the search for self-satisfaction and direct them towards the truth.
