IN TODAY'S GOSPEL...

The Eucharist is the mystery of transformation. God transforms bread and wine into His Body and Blood. One of the many mysteries of the transfiguration, the divine mysteries of transfiguration. Just as the incarnation is a moment of transfiguration, just as the event on Mount Tabor is a moment of transfiguration, when the humanity of Jesus shines with divinity, just as the entire Paschal Triduum, Jesus' death and resurrection, is an incredible moment of transfiguration, so the Eucharist is a moment of transfiguration.

It is shocking at first that God has such an ability to transform. This is what philosophers have never dreamed of. Every decent exposition of philosophy about God, the philosophy of God, emphasizes God's immutability. It is emphasized that God is unchangeable in his nature, because he is holy, because he is perfect. Since He is perfect, He cannot change. In such a classic interpretation, God cannot suffer either, because suffering appears precisely where there is some change.

What philosophy can say about God is important, but it has its limits, just as the human mind is limited. In fact, human love is also limited. Man does not believe that God can be so extraordinary. But there is change in God, and this change is always dictated by love - love for man.

It is great news that God can be changeable, that he very often decides to change, but because he is somehow flexible in the encounter with man, he is sensitive, man is really a subject for him. It is for man that God is able to change in many ways.

Let us ask ourselves during this day of the Feast of Corpus Christi whether we are also ready for change. Isn't it the case that we are fixated, everyone in their own positions: everything is clear, arranged, I won't move from here? To what extent do we have the disposition to change? Not for the sake of change, but for the love of the One who loves us first and Himself brings about a transformation in our lives that philosophers cannot imagine.
