

IN TODAY'S GOSPEL...

The Holy Spirit, the Spirit of love, descended on Cornelius and his loved ones, before Peter was completely convinced of the wisdom of announcing the Gospel of Jesus to these people. Spiritual life exists only thanks to the Holy Spirit, who floods the human heart with love like a flood. There must be at least one crack in us for this to happen! When even one feature, one movement occurs inside us, love breaks in and prompts us to love others. God gives himself to me in complete trust in me, even though I cannot trust myself yet. Jesus offers his disciples the love that he himself experiences from the Father.

Isn't this jaw-droppingly amazing? God's love hides nothing, hides nothing, gives itself in part or only in one aspect, but it needs at least one movement of my heart to break in with unstoppable power. Jesus said: I have made it known to you EVERYTHING, which means that He did not hide anything from them, He revealed Himself completely! The love we have received from Jesus cannot remain hidden within us, become our private matter, but demands to be poured out even on someone as distant as Cornelius for Peter! Once you have been loved, you must love one another. But what have I done to make God love me completely? God wants to love all people so much that one righteous person is enough for him to love everyone. God is looking for at least one good word, or one noble thought, or one righteous gesture, to have a gap in me through which He will break in with the love that is His Spirit. In a mountain dam, one crack is enough for the water element to pour out with the force of a flood to the areas beyond!

In the Song of Songs (4:9) it is recorded that the Bridegroom fell in love with the Bride because of one look in her eyes and one bead on her necklace. The original Song of Songs uses the word ANAK at this point, which is usually translated as 'tiny bead of a necklace'. But the word also means GIANT or COLOSSUS! Perhaps one prayer, the smallest but sincere as gold, has the power to make a huge impression on God, to become a huge reason for pouring out His love on us. God loves to be charmed by us and looks for at least one reason to love us. If only there was at least one reason in us to make this love possible for Him. Jechiel Heller wrote it this way: "You can charm me even with one righteous person, you attract me to yourself when you keep even one commandment." One righteous man was enough: Jesus Christ for God to be enchanted by all of humanity, and it is enough for us to keep one commandment of love for the heavenly valves of God's love to open, spilling out into the areas of human existence.

BAPTISMS (1st & 3rd Sat.)

- Baptism Information Form must be filled out by mother or father. Form may be picked up from the Parish Office.
- 2. A copy of the child's official birth certificate from Public Health.
- 3. Submission of Godparent(s) Sponsor Form from parish priest where they attend mass. If the sponsor(s) are parishioners of Santa Bernadita, they must call to make an appointment to meet with the priest.

Baptism Class & Baptism will not be scheduled until all required documents have been submitted to the office.
